Arrival at Amsterdam Schiphol airport arrival and team rendezvous. Portland, Atlanta, & San Francisco all arrive at separate times.

Afternoon/Evening

Arrive in Dar es Salaam, Tanzania. Process our Tanzanian visas - all you need is your passport, your visa is pre-paid - and then collect our luggage. We will be greeted at the airport by friends from New Hope for Girls - Diana will be greeted in the afternoon as she arrives.

Drive to the Greenlight Hotel in Tabata, a suburb of Dar es Salaam with check-in likely close to midnight. You can look forward to a clean, safe and welcoming accommodation. You'll have your own room with air conditioning and private bath. We stay here the first nights to be in an ordinary neighborhood and located within walking or tuk-tuk distance. Showers are sometimes hot and WIFI is available in the lobby, dining room and periodically in guest rooms.
